Celebrate Mom or the leading lady in your life! Enjoy tea, lemonade, and delicate finger foods in a quaint setting.

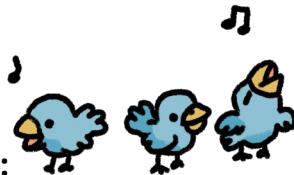
Registration is required as seating is limited. All ages (Kids-Adults), call now and sign up! This event is FREE to attend.

In addition to the presentation we will also be hosting a **seedling exchange** for those who may have extra seedlings.



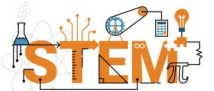
## STEM Monday:
