Betty Brandt Passick is an independent author, inspirational



speaker, and teacher. A decade ago she began her career as an author. In November 2021 she published her fourth book: The Black Bag of Dr. Wiltse, Murder on the Prairie (2021), book two

in the Gangster series. The novel tells the forgotten legacy of Dr. Alexander Wiltse—who, in the mid-1850s, left behind his beloved ancestral home in

Ontario, Canada to establish new roots in Iowa. Her first novel in the Gangster Series, Gangster in Our Midst, Bookkeeper, lieutenant, and sometimes hitman for Al

Capone (2017), won a 2019 Notable 100 Indie Book Award. Passick currently resides in the Twin Cities in Minnesota. She also teaches writing workshops, writes a "Gangster Blog," and is a columnist for her hometown newspaper, the Fairbank Islander.
