Bring your school aged kids in for a lesson on how the 3D printer works, and how to use it!

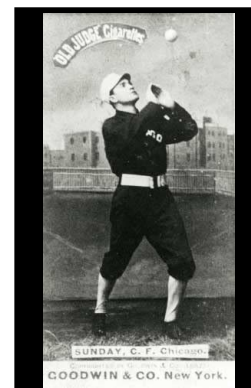
Tablets and laptops are encouraged, but not required to participate.

Come and hear author **Craig Bishop** speak on Billy Sunday's life and ministry.

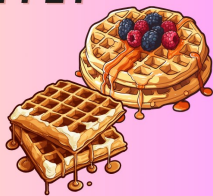
Both men share traditional moral views along with the conviction to share them with those they come in contact with. Listen to the history behind the baseball evangelist, **Billy Sunday**.

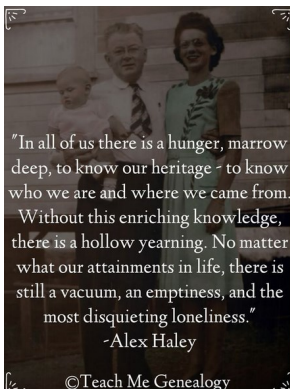
How's your garden going? Need some suggestions? Let's talk about it!
