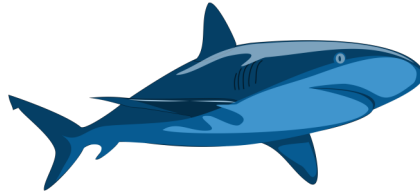

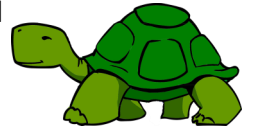
### Blank Park Zoo:
